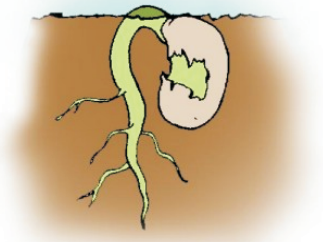


Beany Baby



Make your own living necklace!

Materials needed

- jewelry size - 2" x 2" zip-close bag (with hang hole)
- Soil Moist™ or similar watering granules
- water
- ¼ teaspoon measuring spoon
- ½ tablespoon measuring spoon
- soybeans
- yarn, cut to 30" lengths

Directions

1. Place a scant ¼ teaspoon of Soil Moist™ into the bag.
2. Add ½ tablespoon of water.
3. Gently push in two soybeans.
4. Seal bag firmly.
5. Insert the yarn to make a necklace.
6. Wear your Beany Baby around your neck and under your shirt to keep it in a warm, dark place.
7. Check your Beany Baby several times a day for germination (sprouting).

About Your Beany Baby

What do seeds need in order to germinate? They need moisture (rain), and heat (sun, which warms the soil). By adding water to your Beany Baby and keeping it warm by wearing it, you are giving the seeds what they need to sprout. Once your seeds germinate, they will need air, light, soil nutrients, and more water. Plant your newly sprouting seeds in a cup of soil and grow your own soybean plants!

ger-mi-nate - when a seed begins to grow and develop, or sprout; generally stimulated by the presence of water at proper temperatures.
